Instructions on how to submit your research:

Each proposal must include the following information:

- Title of the presentation
- Every authors' name & classification
(e.g., undergraduate, graduate student, or faculty mentor), & affiliation (institution and department)
- First author's mailing address, telephone number, and e-mail address
- A one- or two-page research summary (500 words max)
- Applicants are asked to divide their 500-word abstract into the following: 1) background, 2) methods, 3) results, 4) conclusion, 5) 3-5 key words
- Please include your preferred presentation format: (1) a poster, or (2) a 30-minute in-person presentation. Please note that only graduate students are eligible for the presentation.
